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For: DETERMINING UPPER OR LOWER OFFSET PATTERN GAGECOCK

Penberthy's upper and lower offset pattern armored gagecocks are not interchangeable. The upper gagecock is a mirror image of the lower gagecock. In the event of replacement of a gagecock, it is necessary to determine which gagecock (upper or lower) is in question.

Procedure to Determine Upper or Lower Gagecock

Position the gagecock so that the handwheel is pointing toward you and the vessel connection is facing away from you. Place the gagecock on a table so that the offset portion of the gagecock rests on the table. If the gage connection (union or rigid) points to the left, it is an upper gagecock. If the gage connection points to the right, it is a lower gagecock.
